# Every school day matters!

Term dates are listed below for the year ahead. The current Government guidelines now make it clear that Headteachers are once again instructed that they may not grant any leave of absence unless there are exceptional

circumstances. As a result, all holiday requests will be unauthorised unless exceptional circumstances can be given. Attendance penalty notices (fines) are issued to anyone who takes a three day break or more within any given six week period.

Any child with attendance of less than 90% will be regarded as a persistent absentee and external agencies may become involved. School will continue to share your child's attendance data will be shared with you each term.
