



Key Vocabulary

County – a region that has its own local government

Ordnance Survey Map – a detailed map that shows all roads, paths etc

Six-figure grid reference – a precise location on a map

Fieldwork – researching in the natural environment

Compass points – marks on a compass showing direction

Digital mapping – collecting map data and displaying electronically

Land use – the way land is used by people, such as housing, industry or green spaces

Housing types – terraced, semi-detached, detached, flats or bungalows

Rural – countryside areas

Urban – built-up areas, relating to towns and cities

Settlement - a place where people live, which can be categorised into villages, towns and cities

Settlement pattern – the shape and spacing of settlements, settlements might be linear (such as following the path of a road or river), dispersed (such as a number of farms), or nucleated (such as a densely settled village or town)

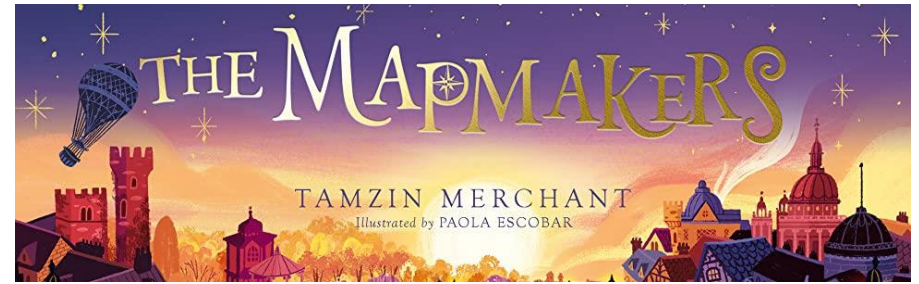
Survey – Information collected by asking questions to a sample of the population
