Ancient Wonders of the World – manmade monuments of the past that were considered worthy of visiting

Physical features – mountains, valleys, rivers etc created naturally

Manmade features – Buildings, monuments etc created by man

Socioeconomic level – the social standing or class of an individual or group

Rural – living in countryside areas

Urban – living in built-up areas

Poverty – unable to fulfil basic needs

Class – groups based on social or economic standing (see socioeconomic level)

Minimum wage – lowest amount per hour a worker can be paid legally
